Requirement: CANCELLED.

This AD is cancelled on 4 June 2009.

Background: This unique Australian AD raised in 1970 against Allison Commercial Engine

Bulletin (CEB) 250 CEB-106 required glass bead peening of engine compressor

blades to increase resistance to fatigue.

Compliance was: Before installation in an aircraft following next overhaul completed

after 1 December 1970.

This AD has been sufficiently promulgated for the affected engines to have been

modified by now; therefore this AD is considered to be no longer required.
