This AD is cancelled on 31 July 2008.

Background: This unique Australian AD, issued prior to 1960 against Aero Design (also known as

Aero Commander) Service Bulletin (SB) No. 20, required the installation of a

reinforcement rib in both wings at station 145 to prevent buckling of the existing rib under certain manoeuvring conditions. Compliance was required forthwith. As all affected aircraft would have been modified long ago, this AD is no longer required.
