On the effective date specified below, and for the reasons set out in the background section, the CASA delegate whose signature appears below revokes Airworthiness Directive AD/CESSNA 180/24.

Fuel Line and Cabin Door Latch

Requirement: CANCELLED.

This AD is cancelled on 5 June 2008.

Background: This unique Australian airworthiness directive (AD), issued in 1978, required modification of the cabin door latch in accordance with Cessna Service Letter SL 66-49 to enable adequate clearance of the fuel line in the door post. The compliance of the AD was before 1 August 1978. As all aircraft would be modified by now, the unsafe condition no longer exists.
