

Requirement: CANCELLED.

This AD is cancelled on 13 March 2008.

Background: This unique Australian AD required installation of a placard specifying periods during which smoking is prohibited, installation of fuelling equipment bonding points, and replacement of specific flexible hose assemblies, all in accordance with ANO 101.22. As ANO 101.22 has been cancelled, the requirements of this directive are no longer appropriate or necessary.
