On the effective date specified below, and for the reasons set out in the background section, the CASA delegate whose signature appears below revokes Airworthiness Directive AD/RAD/11 Amdt 2.

VHF Transceiver - Modification

4/2009

Requirement: CANCELLED.

This AD is cancelled on 9 April 2009.

Background: This unique Australian AD was raised in 1966 requiring a modification to AN/ARC/1 series VHF Transceivers to reduce second harmonic radiation from the transmitter to a level at least 40 db below the carrier power at the fundamental frequency due to spurious radiation from this equipment causing serious interference to other communication systems.

Compliance was before 31 July 1966.

Given the extended period this AD has been promulgated, and that affected VHF Transceivers would have been modified by now, this AD is considered to be no longer required.
