Background: This unique Australian AD was raised in 1971 requiring a modification to Aerosound

555-900 Press-to-Talk assembly to ensure that a transmitter would not remain

energised after the Press-to-Talk button is released.

Incorporation of Air Communications Pty. Ltd. modification specification

AC-M-1004 was an acceptable means of compliance.

Compliance was before 1 April 1971.

Given the extended period this AD has been promulgated, and that affected Press-to-Talk assemblies would have been modified by now, this AD is considered to be no

longer required.
