Background: This unique Australian AD was raised in 1976 against Sunair Service Bulletin (SB)

No. 100A-001, dated 15 April 1974, requiring a modification to Sunair HF

Transceiver ASB -100 and -100A due possible smoke/fire hazard would exit if a short

of primary wires occurred carrying power to the receiver/exciter, or the antenna

tuning unit.

Compliance was before 31 March 1977.

Given the extended period this AD has been promulgated, and that affected HF Transceiver would have been modified by now, this AD is considered to be no longer

required.
