AD/RAD/56 Honeywell, Commercial Flight Systems Group, 10/2006 TCAS II Processors

Requirement: CANCELLED.

This AD is cancelled on 28 September 2006.

Background: The original issue of this Directive required the software of certain Honeywell International TCAS II processors be upgraded to Version 6.04A 'enhanced'. This requirement is redundant as all Airborne Collision Avoidance Systems in Australia must now incorporate Version 7 software (see Civil Aviation Regulation (1988) 262AB).
