Compliance: Prior to further flight after 30 September 1993 and thereafter at each subsequent 'A'

check or after 300 flight cycles, whichever is the sooner, until a modified Safeflight

Windshear Computer is installed.

Background: BAe have received reports that the windshear computer may not detect the loss of flap

position signal, this may result in incorrect guidance information being displayed on the flight director. Compliance with this Directive will increase the possibility of

early detection of the fault.
