550-30-05, required inspections that would ensure that the TKS fluid tube assemblies of the anti-ice system were correctly identified and routed. Compliance was required

before issue of a certificate of airworthiness.

As all affected aircraft will have been inspected and modified long ago, this AD is no

longer required.
