Compliance: Unless previously accomplished by 9 July 1998.

This airworthiness directive becomes effective on 9 October 1997.

Background: Some operators have reported chafing of electrical wiring at the forward, top,

outboard edge of the lavatory side wall resulting in severe local overheat and smoke in the cockpit and cabin. The deHavilland modification 8/2624 provides the means for assessing the condition of the affected wires, repair any damage and reduce the risk of future damage to the wiring harness in the area behind the lavatory and cut

away of the lavatory forward panel.
