Background: The Swedish Airworthiness Authority has advised that Electromagnetic Interference

(EMI) tests indicate that the actuator assemblies of certain fuel shut-off valves may fail to function after exposure to EMI, such as lightning or high intensity radiated fields (HIRF). Loss of function of the fuel shut-off valves, if not detected or corrected in a timely manner, could result in unchecked fuel leakage or fuel

imbalance. Compliance with this Directive decreases the likelihood of EMI affecting

the fuel valves.
