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## AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVE

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For the reasons set out in the background section, the CASA delegate whose signature appears below issues the following Airworthiness Directive (AD) under subregulation 39.1 (1) of CASR 1998. The AD requires that the action set out in the requirement section (being action that the delegate considers necessary to correct the unsafe condition) be taken in relation to the aircraft or aeronautical product mentioned in the applicability section: (a) in the circumstances mentioned in the requirement section; and (b) in accordance with the instructions set out in the requirement section; and (c) at the time mentioned in the compliance section.

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### SAAB SF340 Series Aeroplanes

**AD/SF340/92**

**Refuelling Door**

**7/2003**

**Applicability:** Model SF340A aircraft, serial numbers 004 through 159.

Model 340B aircraft, serial numbers 160 through 459.

**Requirement:** Action in accordance with Saab Aircraft Mandatory Service Bulletin No. 340-57-042, dated 7 May 2003.

*Note: LFV AD 1-187 refers.*

**Compliance:** Before 8 May 2005.

This Airworthiness Directive becomes effective on 10 July 2003.

**Background:** The manufacturer received reports of wear on the signal conditioner harness, located behind the wing refuelling panel. This Directive requires relocation of the refuelling panel most outboard latch in order to eliminate wear on the harness.
