This AD is cancelled on 4 June 2009.

Background: This unique Australian AD raised prior to 1962 against DH Mod G1329: or ANO 106.1.7.6.5.6, applicable to Gipsy Queen 70 series engines modified to Mod.G1213, required a modification to the sun gear distance piece.

Compliance was: Before installation in an aircraft.

This AD has been sufficiently promulgated for the affected engines to have been modified by now; therefore this AD is considered to be no longer required.
