The AD requires that the action set out in the requirement section (being action that the delegate considers necessary to correct the unsafe condition) be taken in relation to the aeronautical product mentioned in the applicability section: (a) in the circumstances mentioned in the requirement section; and (b) in accordance with the instructions set out in the requirement section, and (c) at the time mentioned in the compliance section.

Requirement: Install a lighting strip (eyebrow lights) on the "NR" indicator in accordance with

Eurocopter AS 350 Mandatory Service Bulletin 33.00.17.

Note: DGAC AD 1999-512-077(A) refers.

Compliance: Before 30 April 2000.

This Airworthiness Directive becomes effective on 23 March 2000.

Background: This Directive ensures that the "NR" indicator is illuminated in both the normal and

emergency modes.
