Requirement: CANCELLED.

This AD is cancelled on 4 June 2009.

Background: This unique Australian AD raised in 1970 against Hughes Service Information Notice (SIN) No. HN-4 required a one-time inspection for NAS1291-4 nuts installed on a number of assemblies that were suspected of being inadequately processed during vendor manufacturing.

Compliance was: Before 1 September 1971.

This AD has been sufficiently promulgated for the affected aircraft to have been inspected by now; therefore this AD is considered to be no longer required.
