(SIN) No. HN-108 required a one-time inspection to ensure that proper and

compatible attach bolts and nuts were used to secure the pitch control rods to the pitch housing assembly. Information given in the SIN is now part of Basic Handbook of

Maintenance Instructions (HMI) and IPC.

Compliance was: Within 100 hours TIS after 31 March 1977.

Given that the requirements of this AD are contained in the HMI and IPC; this AD is considered to be no longer required.
