This AD is cancelled on 4 June 2009.

Background: This unique Australian AD raised in 1979 against Hughes Service Information Notice

(SIN) No. DN-34 required a modification to replace the engine oil cooler to engine oil tank return hose with a longer hose assembly to reduce the possibility of vibration

induced damage to oil tank or oil cooler assemblies.

Compliance was: As detailed in the requirement document; which was within next

100 hours of helicopter operation after receipt of parts.

This AD has been sufficiently promulgated for the affected aircraft to have been modified by pays therefore this AD is considered to be no longer required.
