Background: This unique Australian AD raised in 1981 against Hughes Service Information Notice

(SIN) No. DN-91 required an inspection for corrosion of the main rotor hub strap

retention bolts and bushings that may have occurred since installation.

Compliance was: Within 100 hours TIS after 30 September 1981, unless already

accomplished within the last 200 hours TIS.

This AD has been sufficiently promulgated for the affected aircraft to have been inspected by now; therefore this AD is considered to be no longer required.
