Background: This AD, raised in 1981 against Hughes Service Information Notice (SIN) No.

DN-96, required a one-time inspection to ensure that a steel washer had not been inadvertently installed under the aluminium rivet securing the sta-strap securing electrical wiring to the boom fairing at STA 138.50. Compliance was required

within 100 hours TIS after 31 December 1981.

As all affected aircraft would have been inspected, and, if necessary, modified long

ago, this AD is no longer required.
