Requirement: Inspect in accordance with Part I and Part II of McDonnell Douglas Helicopter

Systems Service Information Notice HN-239, DN-188, EN-81, FN-67, or NN-008, as

applicable.

Note: FAA AD 96-10-09 Amdt 39-9615 refers.

Compliance: For Part I: Unless the initial inspection has already been accomplished, within 10

hours time in service after 17 June 1996.

For Part II: Within 100 hours time in service after 17 June 1996, thereafter at

intervals not to exceed 100 hours time in service.

Background: The FAA received a report of one accident in which a blade separated from the

helicopter, as well as eight other reports of cracked blades. The actions specified in this Directive are intended to prevent failure of a blade and subsequent loss of control

of the helicopter.
