AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVE

The AD requires that the action set out in the requirement section (being action that the delegate considers necessary to correct the unsafe condition) be taken in relation to the aeronautical product mentioned in the applicability section: (a) in the circumstances mentioned in the requirement section; and (b) in accordance with the instructions set out in the requirement section; and (c) at the time mentioned in the compliance section.

Compliance: Before 30 December 2000, unless already accomplished.

This Airworthiness Directive becomes effective on 23 March 2000.

Background: The JCAB requires the installation of a hook system to the doors of the transmission

and engine cowlings to prevent the doors from opening fully during flight; in the event of the door fasteners not being correctly latched during pre-flight check.
