Background: This unique Australian AD raised in 1974 required a modification by installation of a low air speed aural warning device to comply with requirements contained in superseded certification legislation.

Compliance was before of a certificate of airworthiness.

The requirements of this AD have been superseded and are now covered elsewhere; therefore this AD is considered to be no longer required.
