Background: This AD was issued in 1973 and required a once-off inspection of certain serial number aircraft to check the wing bolts for fitment of incorrect washers. During a review of airframe ADs for other Beech models, it was determined that this requirement could be cancelled because with the passage of time all affected aircraft have by now been inspected, and the fact that none of the affected Beech 33 models remain on the Australian Register.
