Beechcraft 55, 58 and 95-55 (Baron) Series Aeroplanes

AD/BEECH 55/9 Rudder Spar and Hinges 10/2009 Amdt 2

Requirement: CANCELLED.

This AD is cancelled on 24 September 2009.

Background: This AD, raised in 1968 against Beechcraft Service Bulletin (SB) 67-34, Rev.1, required an inspection for cracking of the rudder spar and alignment of hinges followed by a modification. Compliance was required within 300 hours TIS from 16 May 1968.

As all affected aircraft would have been inspected, and, if necessary, modified long ago, this AD is no longer required.
