Requirement: CANCELLED.

Background: This Directive required placard installation to prohibit pressurised operation of certain

serial number aeroplanes if they did not have upgraded pilot's side windows installed. Compliance date was 28 June 1974. During a review of airframe ADs for the Beech heavy twin engine models, it was determined that this requirement could be cancelled because with the passage of time all affected aircraft will by now have been modified

and have the upgraded windows installed.
