This AD is cancelled on 10 April 2008.

Background: This unique Australian airworthiness directive (AD) was raised against a

manufacturer's service letter rather than a State of Design AD and required

replacement of the hose assembly, from the turbocharger oil return line, to improve reliability and service life. Compliance was required with in 100 hours time in service after 31 July 1979. As all affected aircraft would now have the hose assembly

replaced, the unsafe condition no longer exists.
