AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVE

The following airworthiness directive (AD) may be applicable to an aircraft which our records indicate is registered in your name. ADs are issued pursuant to Canadian Aviation Regulation (CAR) 593. Pursuant to CAR 605.84 and the further details of CAR Standard 625, Appendix H, the continuing airworthiness of a Canadian registered aircraft is contingent upon compliance with all applicable Ads. Failure to comply with the requirements of an AD may invalidate the flight authorization of the aircraft. Alternative means of compliance shall be applied for in accordance with CAR 605.84 and the above- referenced Standard.

65-4 FOUND

Applies to Found Bros. FBA-2C aircraft modified in accordance with Found Bros. Drawing 2C22-2, together with ECN's 2C22 Issue 1A and 1B.

Compliance required within 100 hours time in service since the incorporation of the modification described in FBA Drawing 2C22-2 and thereafter at intervals not to exceed 100 hours time in service since the last inspection.

Conduct a visual inspection of the tailplane box skin P/N S50-31, gusset plate P/N S50-87, and hinge brackets P/N S101-1, for signs of cracking. If a crack exists the cracked part shall be replaced before further flight, unless repaired in accordance with a method specifically approved by the Regional Aeronautical Engineer, Department of Transport, Toronto Region.

Report any cracks to the Regional Airworthiness Inspector.

Pursuant to CAR 202.51 the registered owner of a Canadian aircraft shall, within seven days, notify the Minister in writing of any change of his or her name or address.
