
AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVE

On the effective date specified below, and for the reasons set out in the background section, the CASA delegate whose signature appears below revokes Airworthiness Directive AD/G164/7 Amdt 2.

Schweizer (Grumman) G-164 (Ag-Cat) Series Aeroplanes

AD/G164/7 **Power Plant Fire Protection - Modification** **8/2009**
Amdt 2

Requirement: CANCELLED.

This AD is cancelled on 30 July 2009.

Background: This unique Australian AD originally raised in 1966 and amended 1982 required a modification in order to comply with power plant fire protection requirements contained in superseded legislation for replacement of fuel and oil system pipe lines and hoses with pipe lines and hoses manufactured from fire resistant material.

Compliance was forthwith.

This AD has been sufficiently promulgated for the affected engines to have been modified by now; therefore this AD is considered to be no longer required.
