This airworthiness directive becomes effective on 18 June 1998.

Background: Application of high control forces can distort the aileron control rod no. 1 (part

> number 115-4400/4401), interfering with proper control of the aircraft. This directive requires installation of a modified control rod with an additional stop to prevent

damage during operation.
