Requirement: CANCELLED.

This AD is cancelled on 3 July 2008.

Background: This Directive specified once-only modification of the horizontal stabiliser trim

control screw mechanism. This Directive was not based on a Piper service document or USA Directive. This Directive has been in force for over 40 years, so all affected aircraft would have been modified long ago. Hence, this AD is no longer required.
