Piper PA-22 (Tri-Pacer and Colt) Series Aeroplanes

AD/PA-22/32 Fuselage Door Frame Tube Corrosion 10/2008 Amdt 2

Requirement: CANCELLED.

This AD is cancelled on 25 September 2008.

Background: This unique Australian AD was introduced in 1986 as a once-only inspection to

achieve compliance with Piper SB No. 819. Amdt 1 in 1986 offered 3 yearly

radiographic inspection as an alternative to the once-only inspection. Amdt 2 in 1993 extended the radiographic inspection interval to 5 years. In 2008 a review of unique

ADs concluded that this maintenance activity no longer warrants an AD.
