This unique Australian AD specified periodic inspection for cracking of the inboard end of the lower flange of the front spar. Compliance was required at intervals not exceeding 100 hours time in service. This AD was based on Australian experience in 1970. There is no similar Piper service document or USA AD. Using an AD to

mandate this periodic inspection is no longer warranted.
