carrying metallic objects on the rear baggage compartment hat shelf. The flux sensor for the Altimatic V Flight Director automatic flight control system is located near the hat shelf. Compliance with Piper SB No. 404 was required within 200 hours time in

service after July 1974. The AD is no longer required.
