Requirement: CANCELLED.

This AD is cancelled on 3 July 2008.

Background: This Directive specified Piper SB No. 350 which called for once-only inspection of stabilator hinge attaching bolts. This Directive was not based on a US Directive. This Directive and SB No. 350 required compliance in 1972 so all affected aircraft would have been modified long ago. Hence, this AD is no longer required.
