Background: This Directive specified Piper SB No. 427 which called for once-only modification of

any aircraft equipped with a factory-installed air conditioning system. This Directive was not based on a US Directive. This Directive required compliance in 1974 so all affected aircraft would have been modified long ago. Hence, this AD is no longer

required.
