Compliance:

The compliance remains unchanged as 'Within 2,000 hours time in service after 9

November 1995'. This amendment is effective from 30 June 1996.

Background:

Action required by this Directive is designed to eliminate the possibility of a failure of the current limiter in combination with an engine failure causing loss of power to the

essential bus.

This amendment revises the serial number range for certain SA-227 aeroplanes and

corrects the SA-227 model designation.

The original issue of this Airworthiness Directive became effective on 9 November

1995.
