Background: This Directive has been cancelled effective 10 January 2000. The Directive has been

cancelled in response to substantial evidence of fuel system contamination reoccurring in aircraft that have complied with the requirements of this Directive. It is
now known that the contaminant is Ethylene Di-Amine (EDA). EDA can exist as a
clear substance as well as a black sticky substance as previously advised. To address
concern for the airworthiness of aircraft refuelled with 100/130 AVGAS now known
to have been contaminated with EDA, AD/GENERAL/78 has been issued, effective

10 January 2000.
